



LEADERSHIP IN POLICE ORGANIZATIONS TRAINING

Thank you for your interest in attending the International Association of Chiefs of Police (IACP) Leadership in Police Organizations (LPO) training. This course is offered in Georgia by the Athens-Clarke County Police Department in partnership with the IACP. **Please read this document carefully to ensure you understand the application process.**

The LPO course offered in Athens lasts three weeks over a three-month period. The three weeks of training are each separated by a three-week period. The dates for the spring 2009 session are below:

Week One – August 10-14
Week Two – September 14-18
Week Three – October 19-23

The basic cost for the three-week course (including textbooks and materials) is \$800. Checks should be made out to the “Athens-Clarke County Police Department,” and are due by the first day of class.

Nine hours of undergraduate college credit are also available through Gainesville State College (GSC) by registering for the GSC “Certificate in Leadership” (LEAD 3000, 3001, and 3002). **This course can qualify for Hope Grant funding.** It is recommended that you apply for Hope funding as soon as possible. The cost for registering through GSC is an additional \$829, including all necessary fees. **Students do not have to register for the GSC certificate**, and can choose to only take the LPO course for Georgia POST credit. However, it is not possible to seek college credit for the course after LPO has been completed; it must be done beforehand. If a student wishes to apply for GSC credit, a complete GSC application must be sent along with this document to the Athens-Clarke County Police Department and arrive by July 1, 2009.

In summary:

- A student may apply to attend the LPO course and just receive POST credit. **The cost is \$800.**
- A student may apply to also receive the GSC “Certificate in Leadership” and receive undergraduate college credit. This costs an **additional \$829. The Hope Grant can apply to this tuition.**
- All application documents (including a complete GSC application) must be sent to the Athens-Clarke County Police Department in time to arrive by July 1, 2009.
- Go to GACollege411.org to complete the Hope Grant application. This should be done as soon as possible.
